Precinct 1: Encompasses all lands South of 22 Mile Road extended West of Keller, North of 18 Mile Road, East of Cedar Springs Ave.

Precinct 3: Encompasses all lands within the Village of Sand Lake limits.

Precinct 2: Will continue to vote in the Township Hall.
