New Polling Location Precincts 1 & 3

Beginning with the Presidential Primary election held on February 8, 2016, **Precinct 1** and **Precinct 3** will be voting in the Community Room at the Nelson Township/Sand Lake Library, 88 Eighth Street, Sand Lake. New voter registration cards were mailed in October indicating the polling location change. Feel free to contact the clerk's office at 636-5332 with questions or concerns.

Precinct 1: Encompasses all lands South of 22 Mile Road extended West of Keller, North of 18 Mile Road, East of Cedar Springs Ave.

Precinct 3: Encompasses all lands within the Village of Sand Lake limits.

Precinct 2: Will continue to vote in the Township Hall.

- Appliances, sheet metal, wire
- Auto Parts and engines (liquids drained)
- Lawn Chairs and lawn mowers
- Fencing (must be flattened & folded)
- Mattresses and propane tanks
- Furniture, carpeting, wood, clothing, glass, etc.
- Tires – must be cut in four pieces like a pie
- Lead acid batteries and CFLs
- Loose items (shingles, drywall, etc) must be bagged/boxed-**No shovel offs***

We WILL NOT accept.....

- Hazardous or toxic waste
- Yard clippings or brush
- Commercial dumping, concrete, or railroad ties
- Garbage
