We WILL accept.....

Appliances
Sheet Metal
Auto Parts and Engines (liquid drained)
Aluminum and Copper Wire
Lawn Chairs and Lawn Mowers
Fencing (must be flattened & folded)
Mattresses
Furniture, carpeting, wood, clothing, glass etc.
Tires – must be cut in four pieces like a pie
Propane Tanks
Lead acid batteries
Compact florescent bulbs
Household batteries
Loose items (shingles, drywall, etc) must be
bagged/boxed

We WILL NOT accept.....

Hazardous or toxic waste Yard clippings or brush Commercial dumping Concrete, railroad ties Liquids (paint, oil etc.) Garbage

No shovel offs of shingles and drywall The above items can be taken to the Rockford transfer station on 10 Mile Road across from Meijer's.

Electronic Waste Acceptable items...

Computers, phones, tools, small appliances, and most anything with a cord or runs on batteries.

TVs and Computer Monitors

COMPRENEW will no long take TVs or CRT style computer monitors free of charge. Please make checks payable to COMPRENEW. No cash will be accepted. The cost to recycle these items:

15"	\$8.00
19"	\$20.00
27"	\$25.00
37"	\$45.00
42" (including projection)	\$50.00

COMPRENEW has to charge because instead of a landfill ban and a strong take-back program like other states. The lack of specificity in current Michigan Take-back law becomes an environmental disaster because Michigan does not ban electronics from landfills. Due to the lack of accountability from this law, manufacturers have reduced the amount of recycling dollars spent in Michigan relating to the products they sell within the state. This change means that citizens, conservation districts, and municipalities will now have to pay a fee to recycle CRT devices, if they choose to recycle.
